Content	<p>BCP must include the minimum healthcare information necessary to properly care for a resident including, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Initial goals based on admission orders. - Physician orders. - Dietary orders. - Therapy services. - Social services. - PASARR recommendation, if applicable. <p>The BCP should include feedback from resident or representative where applicable.</p> <p>The Comprehensive Care Plan can replace the Baseline Care Plan if it meets the criteria for comprehensive assessment (see next column)</p>	<p>CPC must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - measurable objectives and timeframes to meet the resident’s medical, nursing, mental and psychosocial needs - it must describe services to be provided to attain or maintain resident’s highest practicable level of well-being - the resident’s desired goals and outcomes - the resident’s preferences and potential for discharge - the discharge plans
Timelines for Completion	<p>Within 48 hours of admission</p> <p>Summary of care and services must be provided to resident with completion of the comprehensive care plan.</p>	<p>Within 21 days of admission</p> <p>(CAA Completion Date can be no later than Admission date + 13 calendar days, Care Plan Completion Date can be no later than CAA completion date +7 calendar days)</p>
