Authentication

Password

A unique username and password is required to access the Practitioner Engagement app.

PointClickCare User Account Management / Security Setup

The Practitioner Engagement app leverages the PointClickCare User Account Management / Security Setup platform to provide access based on configured security functions and authenticate users.

Two-Factor Authentication

Two-Factor Authentication is available for clinicians who are required an additional measure of security to verify their user identity. PointClickCare is the first long-term healthcare company to embed a two-step verification process directly into its EHR platform. Today, practitioners in Ohio, Massachusetts, Louisiana are required to utilize two-factor authentication for e-signatures.

Data-In-Transit

To protect patient information from unauthorized virtual access, the Practitioner Engagement app encrypts data while it in in transit to the mobile device (Data-In-Transit) into a form that cannot be read without the decryption key or password. SSL over HTTPS is used.

Data-At-Rest

The Practitioner Engagement app does not store data on the mobile device. Privacy and security does not apply.
