



Supporting Maternal Health from Pre-to-Post Natal



Early Identification Programs Improve Maternal Outcomes

Women without prenatal care are seven times more likely to deliver preterm¹, three to four times more likely to die from pregnancy complications², and five times more likely to lose their infants.

Each premature birth costs Medicaid about \$43,858 versus \$1,894 for a healthy birth. A Medicaid study³ found that maternal care-management programs cut preterm births by 22 percent and lowered pregnancy weight gain by seven pounds, driving down costs and saving lives.
